Veteran Banner – Order Form

Who is Eligible to be Honoured on a Banner:

- Any man or woman, living or deceased, who served, or continues to serve Canada or its allies, in a war or on a peacekeeping mission
- The person should have some connection to the Collingwood area (born, grew up, or lived here, or related to a current resident)
- There must be a picture of the person available of sufficient resolution to be reproduced on a banner. A photography shop may be able to work with an original photograph to ensure that the resolution is sufficient. Please contact the BIA office if you require more information.

Where and When will the Banners be displayed:

- The banners will be displayed every year in Downtown Collingwood from mid-October to after Remembrance Day, in conjunction with Downtown's poppy banner program
- The banners will be displayed for as many years as they remain in good repair. When normal wear and tear prevents its display, sponsors will have the option to replace it.

How to Order:

- Fill out the order form attached and mail or drop off with payment to the Collingwood Downtown BIA office at 105 Hurontario Street, P.O. Box 23, Collingwood, ON L9Y 3Z4

- The Veteran's Information, along with a high resolution picture should accompany the form, or may be scanned and emailed as noted on the form.
